Operations & Maintenance

Over the past several months, the District has experienced multiple minor leaks associated with water boxes throughout the system. In addition, there have been three (3) significant main line breaks. One of these major breaks resulted in the depletion of the District's water storage tanks and caused damage to the culvert located on Red Bluff Road, as well as damage to adjacent private property. These incidents led to insurance claims, all of which have since been addressed and resolved. All repairs related to these events have been completed, and the system is currently operating under normal conditions.

SCADA & Communications

The District has recently encountered issues related to SCADA and system communications. These problems have contributed to intermittent water pressure loss, primarily due to electrical interruptions that have caused wells and booster pumps to shut down. A technician is scheduled to be onsite next week to evaluate the current auto-dialer system and overall communications infrastructure. The goal is to identify necessary repairs or recommend upgrades that will improve system reliability and prevent future service disruptions. Investment in updated communication equipment is expected to reduce the likelihood of these issues moving forward.

Personnel

Michael, the District's laborer, continues to perform well. No additional personnel-related issues or updates at this time.

Summary

All major repairs have been completed and claims resolved. Focus is now on improving system reliability through SCADA and communication upgrades. No other significant issues to report.
